

# Pre-Junior - Flowers

## **Rules:**

1. The Exhibit Hall will be open to accept exhibits the Wednesday before Labor Day from 5:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. and the Thursday before Labor Day from 8:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.
2. Exhibitors may only enter one exhibit per class.
3. Judging will take place Thursday after 6:00 p.m.
4. Flowers must be grown, selected, and arranged by the exhibitor.
5. Containers are to be furnished by the exhibitor and must have the exhibitor's name on the bottom. In addition to vases, peanut butter, jelly jars, etc. may be used except for the arrangement class.
6. Endangered species may not be used.

## **Hints:**

- Use only the exact number of specimens specified.
- Uniformity in size, shape, and color.
- Quality. Not too large and not too small.
- Free from bruises, cuts, blemishes, and insect injury.
- Product should be wiped clean.

P11 - Small Marigold (5 blooms)  
P12 - Small Zinnia (5 blooms)  
P13 - Flowers, Any Other (5 blooms with name)  
P14 - Arrangement of Fresh Flowers  
P15 - Any House Plant  
P16 - Gladiolus (1 spike)  
P17 - Sunflower (largest head)  
P18 - Large Dahlias (1 bloom)  
P19 - Small Dahlias (5 blooms)  
P20 - Terrarium
