SPENCER FAIR RULES  
FOR LAWN and GARDEN TRACTORS STONE BOAT ON DIRT

Competitors do need to pay General Admission to the Fair

#### General Rules

The tractor pulling contest is open to 2 wheel drive, rear wheel drive, rubber tired tractors only. No recapped tires, no dual wheels, no chains, studs, paddle Cut tires or ATV tires. No 4 wheel drive.

No turbo chargers, no superchargers or nitrous oxide allowed.

Flag man has final say on all pulls including any pull attempt considered unsafe.

All tractors must have a seat and hood, working brakes and steering and have the mowing deck or any other attachments removed.

Tractor must be in good working order.

Foot pedals and electric pumps are allowed.

Exhaust – if not using stock exhaust then all pipes must discharge upwards.

All tractors must have wheelie bars and a hitch height no higher than 12” from the ground.

All pullers must wear closed toe shoes.

\*\*Children must be at least 8 years old and those between 8 – 16 must wear helmets. Children must be able to steer and stop the tractor on their own. An adult is allowed to walk next to them while they pull.

A driver’s meeting will be held 10 minutes prior to the start of the pull. At that time classes will be decided. Once classes are decided, order of go will be determined.

First driver in the first round of each class may opt to pull again only if you remain inbounds. If the driver decides to pull again, only the 2nd pull attempt will count.

Classes are no charge. After you enter a class, please be ready to go once the class begins. If you need to scratch from a class, please let the Pull Secretary know.

After classes are determined, please weigh in your tractor if entering a specific weight class. Please use caution while driving onto and off of the scale.

#### Pulling Rules

All tractors must be operated in a safe manner at all times.

All tractors will be allowed 3 attempts to make a full pull.

Any tractors that complete a full pull of 50 feet will stay by the track for a second round.

If first attempt in the first round is less than 25 feet, you may re-hook. Second attempt will count.

All wheels of the tractor must stay within the marked lanes or be disqualified for that pull attempt.

All weights must stay on the tractor. If any weights fall off you will be disqualified for that pull attempt.

Only one person is allowed on any tractor at any time and the driver must remain seated for the duration of the pull attempt.

The driver MUST keep 1 hand on the steering wheel at all times.

Watch the flag man and obey his directions.
