Rules:

1. This show will be governed by the latest Show Rules and Standards of Perfection of the American Rabbit Breeders Association. Your entry indicates the acceptance of these rules and any other rules set by the association. This is an ARBA sanctioned show.
2. All entries must be postmarked no later than Thursday August 22nd. Please mail early to ensure your entry is received on time. Entries are limited and accepted on a first come, first served basis.
3. Entries will be limited to fifteen (15) rabbits per exhibitor or thirty (30) rabbits per family. Pets will be limited to two (2) per exhibitor. Additional limits may be imposed based on cage availability and will be at the discretion of the superintendents.
4. All entries must be mailed to listed show superintendents. Entry form is available online.
5. Rabbits are to remain until the Monday of the Fair at 5:00pm.
6. Exhibitors will not be allowed into their cages after Thursday night until check-out time on Monday. The committee will be responsible for the care of animals during the Fair. The Fair Association will provide feed for the animals.
7. All ARBA rabbits are to be permanently tattooed in the left ear, and it must be legible as per ARBA rules.
8. Exhibitor must supply two (2) heavy weight dishes for each rabbit entered.
9. Check in time is from 4:00pm until 7:00pm the Thursday before the Fair. Judging will start 7:00pm or earlier of the same day if all exhibits of a breed are checked-in.
10. An entry fee of \$1.00 per rabbit must accompany each entry. Checks should be made payable to the Spencer Agricultural Association.
11. All animals must be free of visual signs of disease. Any rabbits shown any signs of disease will be removed at the discretion of the show superintendents. Health Certificates are required per the State Vet of Massachusetts

Trophies will be awarded for Best in Show and Best Reserve in Show ARBA as well as Best Pet Rabbit and Best Reserve Pet Rabbit.

Classes

Prizes: First - \$6.00, Second - \$5.00, Third - \$4.00

A1 - Pedigree Senior Buck (male over 6 months of age)

A2 - Pedigree Senior Doe (female over 6 months of age)

A3 - Pedigree Intermediate Buck (male over 6 and under 8 months of age, maturing over 10lbs.)

A4 - Pedigree Intermediate Doe (female over 6 and under 8 months of age, maturing over 10lbs.)

A5 - Pedigree Junior Buck (male under 6 months of age)

A6 - Pedigree Senior Doe (female under 6 months of age)

A7 - Pet Class

Rabbit Costume Class - Monday at 1:00 (ribbons only)

1. No costume that will hurt or harm the bird.
2. Exhibitors must be present during the contest.

Rabbit Showmanship - Sunday at 1:00

Pre-Junior Division: Under the age of 8, (ribbons only).

2. Junior Division: Ages 8 to 11
3. Intermediate Division: Ages 12 to 14.
4. Senior Division: Ages 15 and older
5. Novice Division: Anyone over the age of 8 (as of Jan. 1st) with no previous showing experience.
6. Adult & Adult Novice Divisions
