## Rules:

3. Judging will take place Thursday after $6: 00$ p.m.
4. All vegetables must be grown, selected, and arranged by the exhibitor.
5. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts requires the exhibit be entered under the individual's name. The farm name may be listed second. Please no advertising.
6. Whenever possible, please name a vegetable variety.
7. Stems must be present for all squash, beans, pumpkins, peppers, and tomatoes.
8. Plates will be provided by the Spencer Fair Exhibit Hall.

- Uniformity - 20\%
- Proper Size and shape - 20\%
- Free of Blemishes - 20\%
- Overall Quality - 40\%
